The Town Selectman have adopted an ordinance establishing a General Assistance Program to provide immediate aid to persons who are unable to provide basic necessities needed to maintain themselves or their families.**

**The ordinance establishes eligibility standards, maximum levels of assistance and administration and appeals procedures to be used for the Town of Eastbrook's GA Program. **The municipality's General Assistant administrator must issue a written decision within 24 hours of receiving an application.**
