FOR INSTANCE IF A VIOLATION IS BROUGHT TO ATTENTION, IT WILL BE ADDRESSED, DISCUSSED AND POSSIBLE APPEALS BOARD, POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS DISCUSSED AND DECISIONS MADE BY THE SELECTBOARD AND CODE ENFORCEMENT AND PLANNING BOARD BEFORE THE TOWN WILL MOST LIKELY CHOOSE TO SPEND COUNTLESS DOLLARS TO TAKE THINGS TO COURT.

SEVERAL PEOPLE ASKING DAN TO REMOVE THE ORGANICE MATTER SECTION-4-3-4 AND 4-3-7 FROM THE DRAFT.
