

Town of Eastbrook General Assistance Notice

The Town of Eastbrook operates a General Assistance Program pursuant to Title 22 MRSA S4305. The Town Selectman have adopted an ordinance establishing a General Assistance Program to provide immediate aid to persons who are unable to provide basic necessities needed to maintain themselves or their families.

The ordinance establishes eligibility standards, maximum levels of assistance and administration and appeals procedures to be used for the Town of Eastbrook's GA Program. A copy of the ordinance and a copy of the State General Assistance Statues are available for public inspection by contacting the GA Administrator, JulieCurtis, at 565-3307.

Persons who wish to apply for General Assistance may do so by contacting the GA Administrator, Julie Curtis, at 669-5877.

The municipality's General Assistant administrator must issue a written decision within 24 hours of receiving an application.
